Week Ending: July 4, 2021

Released: July 6, 2021

According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Mississippi, there were 5.7 days suitable for fieldwork for the **week ending Sunday, July 4, 2021**. Topsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 14 percent short, 80 percent adequate, and 6 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 1 percent very short, 9 percent short, 85 percent adequate, and 5 percent surplus. Low temperatures ranged from 63.6 degrees Fahrenheit at Lambert to 74.0 degrees Fahrenheit at Belzoni. Highs ranged from 86.4 degrees Fahrenheit at Biloxi to 92.2 degrees Fahrenheit at Laurel. Light precipitation was received throughout the State, with the highest concentration in the northeast of the State with an average of 2.03 inches.
