Week Ending: July 11, 2021

Released: July 12, 2021

According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Mississippi, there were 5.8 days suitable for fieldwork for the **week ending Sunday, July 11, 2021**. Topsoil moisture supplies were 2 percent very short, 24 percent short, 68 percent adequate, and 6 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 1 percent very short, 20 percent short, 74 percent adequate, and 5 percent surplus. Low temperatures ranged from 65.0 degrees Fahrenheit at Lambert to 75.0 degrees Fahrenheit at Saucier. Highs ranged from 83.0 degrees Fahrenheit at Saucier to 91.0 degrees Fahrenheit at Belzoni. Light to heavy precipitation was received throughout the State, with the highest concentration in the south central part of the State with an average of 4.32 inches.
