Week Ending: September 5, 2021

Released: September 7, 2021

According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Mississippi, there were 4.3 days suitable for fieldwork for the **week ending Sunday, September 5, 2021**. Topsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 7 percent short, 84 percent adequate, and 9 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 13 percent short, 79 percent adequate, and 8 percent surplus. Low temperatures ranged from 63.3 degrees Fahrenheit at University to 76.0 degrees Fahrenheit at Saucier. Highs ranged from 79.5 degrees Fahrenheit at Poplarville to 90.4 degrees Fahrenheit at Columbia. Medium to heavy precipitation was received throughout the State, with the highest concentration in the south central part of the State with an average of 6.53 inches.
