Week Ending: November 14, 2021

Released: November 15, 2021

According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Mississippi, there were 5.2 days suitable for fieldwork for the **week ending Sunday, November 14, 2021**. Topsoil moisture supplies were 3 percent very short, 22 percent short, 69 percent adequate, and 6 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 3 percent very short, 23 percent short, 68 percent adequate, and 6 percent surplus. Low temperatures ranged from 31.7 degrees Fahrenheit at Winona to 49.7 degrees Fahrenheit at Biloxi. Highs ranged from 65.3 degrees Fahrenheit at Lambert to 72.0 degrees Fahrenheit at Hattiesburg. Light precipitation was received throughout the State, with the highest concentration in the lower delta part of the State with an average of 0.30 inch.
