Week Ending: November 21, 2021

Released: November 22, 2021

According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Mississippi, there were 5.7 days suitable for fieldwork for the **week ending Sunday, November 21, 2021**. Topsoil moisture supplies were 2 percent very short, 15 percent short, 78 percent adequate, and 5 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 2 percent very short, 20 percent short, 74 percent adequate, and 4 percent surplus. Low temperatures ranged from 32.3 degrees Fahrenheit at University to 47.0 degrees Fahrenheit at Hattiesburg. Highs ranged from 65.0 degrees Fahrenheit at Winona to 75.0 degrees Fahrenheit at Laurel. Trace precipitation was received throughout the State, with the highest concentration in the south-central part of the State with an average of 0.39 inch.
