JULY - SEPTEMBER 2022 QUARTERLY MILK PRODUCTION MOUNTAIN REGION HIGHLIGHTS

Arizona dairy herds produced 1.10 billion pounds of milk during the July - September quarter, up 1.5 percent from the previous year.

Colorado dairy herds produced 1.35 billion pounds of milk during the July - September quarter, up 2.5 percent from the previous year.

Montana dairy herds produced 57.0 million pounds of milk during the July - September quarter, down 6.6 percent from the previous year.

New Mexico dairy herds produced 1.74 billion pounds of milk during the July - September quarter, down 4.9 percent from the previous year.

Utah dairy herds produced 554.0 million pounds of milk during the July - September quarter, down 1.4 percent from the previous year.

Wyoming dairy herds produced 62.2 million pounds of milk during the July - September quarter, up 10.3 percent from the previous year.

UNITED STATES HIGHLIGHTS

Milk production in the United States during the July - September quarter totaled 56.5 billion pounds, up 1.2 percent from the July - September quarter last year.
