JANUARY - MARCH 2023 QUARTERLY MILK PRODUCTION MOUNTAIN REGION HIGHLIGHTS

Arizona dairy herds produced 1.24 billion pounds of milk during the January – March quarter, down 1.4 percent from the previous year.

Colorado dairy herds produced 1.30 billion pounds of milk during the January – March quarter, down 0.4 percent from the previous year.

Montana dairy herds produced 53.0 million pounds of milk during the January – March quarter, down 7.0 percent from the previous year.

New Mexico dairy herds produced 1.80 billion pounds of milk during the January – March quarter, down 4.3 percent from the previous year.

Utah dairy herds produced 521.0 million pounds of milk during the January – March quarter, down 2.3 percent from the previous year.

Wyoming dairy herds produced 58.6 million pounds of milk during the January – March quarter, up 4.5 percent from the previous year.

UNITED STATES HIGHLIGHTS

Milk production in the United States during the January - March quarter totaled 56.8 billion pounds, up 1.0 percent from the January - March quarter last year.
