## NEBRASKA CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION

**LINCOLN, Neb. March 29, 2021** - For the week ending March 28, 2021, topsoil moisture supplies rated 5% percent very short, 14% short, 70% adequate, and 11% surplus, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Subsoil moisture supplies rated 8% very short, 30% short, 58% adequate, and 4% surplus.

**Field Crops Report:** Winter wheat condition rated 5% very poor, 12% poor, 45% fair, 36% good, and 2% excellent.

Weekly reports will begin April 5<sup>th</sup> for the 2021 season.

Data for this news release were provided at the county level by USDA Farm Service Agency, UNL Extension Service, and other reporters across the State.
