## NEBRASKA CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION

**LINCOLN, Neb. February 27, 2023** - For the week ending February 26, 2023, topsoil moisture supplies rated 13% very short, 35% short, 44% adequate, and 8% surplus, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Subsoil moisture supplies rated 30% very short, 43% short, 26% adequate, and 1% surplus.

**Field Crops Report:** Winter wheat condition rated 11% very poor, 29% poor, 41% fair, 18% good, and 1% excellent.

The next report will be issued March 27, 2023.
