NEBRASKA CROP PRODUCTION REPORT

LINCOLN, Neb. July 12, 2023 - Based on July 1 conditions, Nebraska's **winter wheat** production is forecast at 33.2 million bushels, up 26% from last year, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Average yield is forecast at 39 bushels per acre, up 7 bushels from 2022. Area to be harvested for grain is estimated at 850,000 acres, up 4% from a year ago.

Oat production is forecast at 1.13 million bushels, up 23% from last year. Average yield is forecast at 45 bushels per acre, down 6 bushels from 2022. Area to be harvested for grain is estimated at 25,000 acres, up 39% from a year ago.
