Weather Summary

The average low temperatures for Nevada ranged from 5 degrees in Ely to 46 degrees in Las Vegas. The average high temperatures ranged from 67 degrees in Elko to 77 degrees in Las Vegas. Precipitation for the state was only observed in Elko with 0.01 inches.

Crops Summary

Days Suitable for Fieldwork: 7.0 days. Topsoil Moisture: 15% very short, 15% short, 65% adequate, and 5% surplus. Subsoil Moisture: 5% very short, 20% short, and 75% adequate. Pasture and Range Condition: 20% poor, 35% fair, 40% good, and 5% excellent. The weather has been predictably dry across the state. The last cutting of **alfalfa** is ongoing. Water for irrigation was still available in central Nevada.


