

JERSEY FRESH AVAILABILITY FOR APRIL 20, 2015

DANDELIONS	Good quality over-wintered Italian bunched product is available now in very light to increasing volume. Spring planted should be available by mid-May.
LEEKS	A very light volume of good quality over-wintered product is starting to become available. Greening up now.
SPINACH	A light volume of good quality over-wintered product is starting to become available. Spring planted should be available by early May.

JERSEY FRESH FORECAST

ASPARAGUS	Harvest should start this weekend with a very light quantity of good quality product. With continued warm weather, and increasing soil temperatures, the harvest will ramp up quickly.
ARUGULA	Harvest should start in 2-3 weeks in light quantity. Volume should pick up each week after that.
BABY SPINACH & ARUGULA	Harvest should start mid-May due to rainy weather which prevented early planting.
BEETS	Transplanting now. Harvest should begin in mid to late May.
CABBAGE	Transplanting now. Won't be ready until late May or early June.
CILANTRO	Harvest starting late next week with a very light quantity of good quality over-wintered product. Spring planted should be available by mid-May.
COLLARDS	Should begin harvesting around the end of May.
DILL	Harvest should start in three weeks in very light quantity. Volume should pick up each week after that.
ESCAROLE & ENDIVE	Should begin harvesting around the end of May.
KALE	Good quality over-wintered product should start next week in very light volume. Volume should pick up each week.
LETTUCE	Should begin harvesting some Boston by early to mid-May. Red & Green Leaf will follow a week later, followed by Romaine around the end of May.
MINT	Very good quality starting in two weeks. Volume should increase each week after that.
PARSLEY	Harvest of good quality over-wintered curly and plain product should begin in two weeks.
RADISHES	Harvest of good quality product should start next week. Volume should pick up each week after that.
STRAWBERRIES	Early harvests of Chandler variety berries are expected to begin in late May, while the bulk of the crop will be harvested towards early June, with lower volumes to continue through mid-June.
SWISS CHARD	Harvest of good quality product should start in mid-May. Volume should pick up each week after that.
TURNIPS	Should begin harvesting in early June.
