

JERSEY FRESH AVAILABILITY FOR MAY 4, 2015

ASPARAGUS	Harvesting very good quality product in fair to increasing volume. With continued warm weather, and increasing soil temperatures, the harvest will ramp up quickly.
CILANTRO	Harvesting good quality over-wintered product in light volume. Spring planted should be available by mid-May.
DANDELIONS	Good quality over-wintered Italian bunched product is available now in light to fair volume. Spring planted should be available by the end of May.
KALE	Good quality over-wintered product harvesting in light to increasing volume. Volume should pick up each week.
LEEKS	A light volume of good quality over-wintered product is available. Greening up now.
RADISHES	Harvesting good quality product in fair to increasing volume. Volume should pick up each week.
SPINACH	A fair to good volume of good quality over-wintered product available. Spring planted should be available by mid-May.

JERSEY FRESH FORECAST

ARUGULA	Harvest should start next week in light quantity. Volume should pick up each week after that.
BABY SPINACH & ARUGULA	Harvest should start mid-May due to rainy weather which prevented early planting.
BEETS	Harvest should begin in late May.
CABBAGE	Won't be ready until late May or early June.
COLLARDS	Should begin harvesting around the end of May.
DILL	Harvest should start next week in very light quantity. Volume should pick up each week after that.
ESCAROLE & ENDIVE	Should begin harvesting around the end of May.
LETTUCE	Should begin harvesting some Boston by mid-May. Red & Green Leaf will follow a week later, followed by Romaine around the end of May.
MINT	Very good quality starting next week in very light quantity. Volume should increase each week after that.
PARSLEY	Harvest of good quality over-wintered curly and plain product should begin next week.
STRAWBERRIES	Early harvests of Chandler variety berries are expected to begin in late May, while the bulk of the crop will be harvested towards early June, with lower volumes to continue through mid-June.
SWISS CHARD	Harvest of good quality product should start in mid-May. Volume should pick up each week after that.
TURNIPS	Should begin harvesting in early June.
