According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in New Jersey, there were 5 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, November 22, 2020. Topsoil moisture supplies were 85 percent adequate and 15 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 80 percent adequate and 20 percent surplus. Pasture conditions were 2 percent poor, 16 percent fair, and 82 percent good.
