According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in New Jersey, there were 6 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, July 18, 2021. Topsoil moisture supplies were 6 percent short, 73 percent adequate, and 21 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 76 percent adequate and 24 percent surplus. Pasture conditions were 8 percent fair, 91 percent good, and 1 percent excellent.

Most of these varieties will finish this week with supplies of John Boy, Redhaven, Flamin Fury PF Lucky 13, and Flamin Fury PF 15 starting toward the end of the week. There should be variable supplies of white-fleshed peaches and flat peaches. This is a season we always have variable supplies as we move from clingstone to freestone varieties. Fruit size, flavor, and color should be good to very good
