According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in New Jersey, there were 6 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, September 5, 2021. Topsoil moisture supplies were 60 percent adequate, and 40 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 74 percent adequate and 26 percent surplus. Pasture conditions were 3 percent poor, 13 percent fair and 84 percent good.
