According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in New Jersey, there were 6 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, June 26, 2022. Topsoil moisture supplies were 13 percent short and 87 percent adequate. Subsoil moisture supplies were 10 percent short and 90 percent adequate. Pasture conditions were 26 percent fair and 74 percent good.
