According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in New Jersey, there were 6.5 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, July 3, 2022. Topsoil moisture supplies were 3 percent very short, 16 percent short and 81 percent adequate. Subsoil moisture supplies were 17 percent short and 83 percent adequate.
