According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in New Jersey, there were 6.5 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, July 17, 2022. Topsoil moisture supplies were 9 percent very short, 43 percent short and 48 percent adequate. Subsoil moisture supplies were 31 percent short and 69 percent adequate. Pasture conditions were 2 percent very poor, 6 percent poor, 52 percent fair and 40 percent good.
