According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in New Jersey, there were 7 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, August 7, 2022. Topsoil moisture supplies were 65 percent very short, 16 percent short and 19 percent adequate. Subsoil moisture supplies were 19 percent very short, 40 percent short and 41 percent adequate. Pasture conditions were 11 percent very poor, 55 percent poor, 22 percent fair and 12 percent good.
