According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in New Jersey, there were 5.0 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, October 9, 2022. Topsoil moisture supplies 94 percent adequate and 6 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 69 percent adequate and 31 percent surplus. Pasture conditions were 19 percent poor, 31 percent fair and 50 percent good.
