According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in New Jersey, there were 6.5 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, October 23, 2022. Topsoil moisture supplies were 2 percent short, 70 percent adequate and 28 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 3 percent short, 91 percent adequate and 6 percent surplus. Pasture conditions were 10 percent poor, 32 percent fair and 58 percent good.
