According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in New Jersey, there were 7.0 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, April 9, 2023. Topsoil moisture supplies were 3 percent very short, 4 percent short, 93 percent adequate, and 0 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 3 percent short, 97 percent adequate, and 0 percent surplus.
