According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in New Jersey, there were 5.5 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, June 25, 2023. Topsoil moisture supplies were 1 percent short, 81 percent adequate, and 18 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 13 percent short and 87 percent adequate. Pasture conditions were 4 percent very poor, 5 percent poor, 31 percent fair, and 60 percent good.
