According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in New Jersey, there were 6.5 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, June 9, 2024. Topsoil moisture supplies were 4 percent short, 94 percent adequate, and 2 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 1 percent very short, 2 percent short, and 97 percent adequate. Pasture conditions were 3 percent poor, 8 percent fair, 86 percent good, and 3 percent excellent.
