According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in New Jersey, there were 7 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, June 23, 2024. Topsoil moisture supplies were 21 percent very short, 42 percent short, and 37 percent adequate. Subsoil moisture supplies were 11 percent very short, 57 percent short, and 32 percent adequate. Pasture conditions were 4 percent very poor, 23 percent poor, 40 percent fair, 31 percent good, and 2 percent excellent.
