According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in New Jersey, there were 7 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, June 30, 2024. Topsoil moisture supplies were 34 percent short and 66 percent adequate. Subsoil moisture supplies were 39 percent short and 61 percent adequate. Pasture conditions were 5 percent poor, 50 percent fair, and 45 percent good.
