According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in New Jersey, there were 6.5 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, May 4, 2025. Topsoil moisture supplies were 25 percent very short, 16 percent short, 47 percent adequate, and 12 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 32 percent very short, 8 percent short, and 60 percent adequate. Pasture conditions were 9 percent very poor, 20 percent poor, 42 percent fair, and 29 percent good.
