According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in New Jersey, there were 7 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, May 11, 2025. Topsoil moisture supplies were 36 percent very short, 13 percent short, 47 percent adequate, and 4 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 22 percent very short, 11 percent short, and 67 percent adequate. Pasture conditions were 9 percent very poor, 12 percent poor, 31 percent fair, 34 percent good, and 14 percent excellent.
