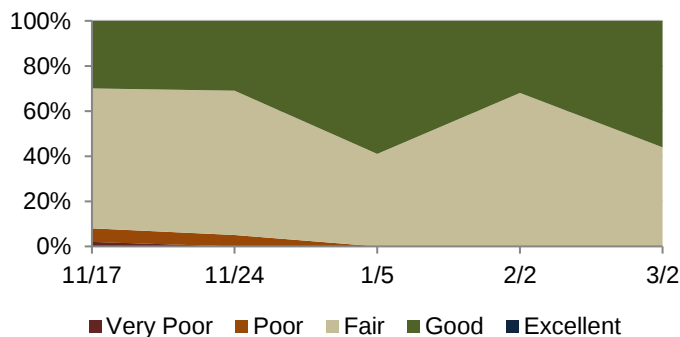

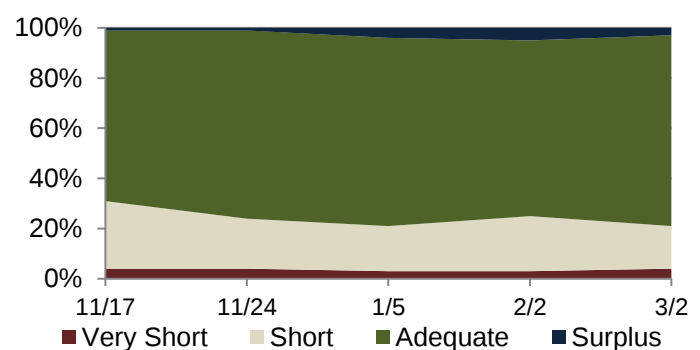

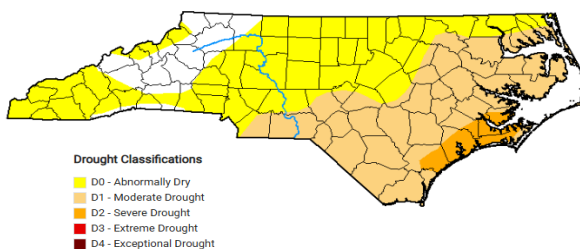


TOPSOIL MOISTURE PERCENT



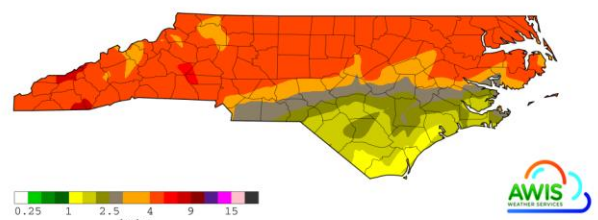
