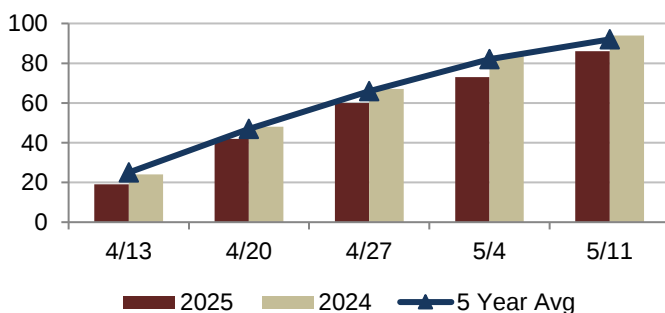

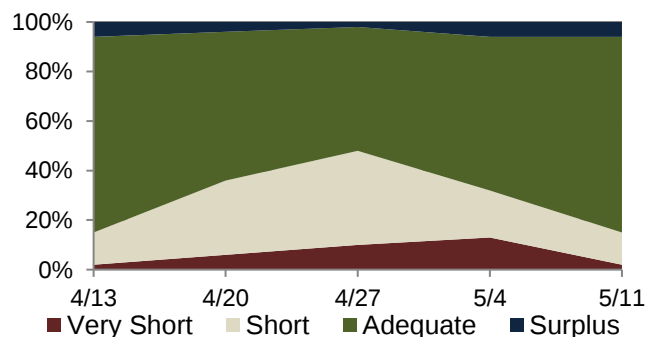

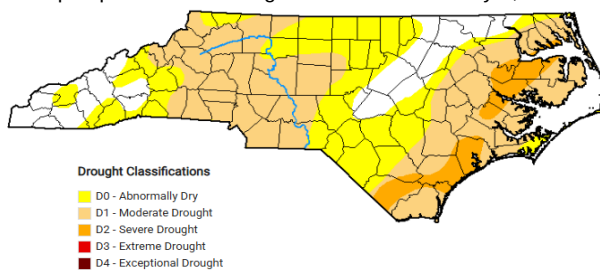
CORN PLANTED



TOPSOIL MOISTURE PERCENT

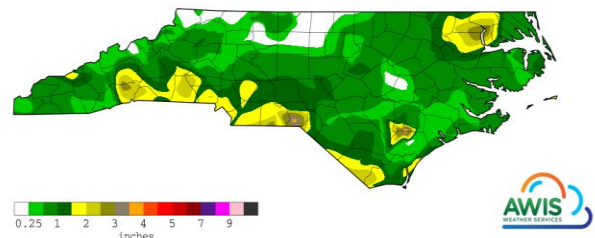


Map depicts current drought conditions as of May 6, 2025.
