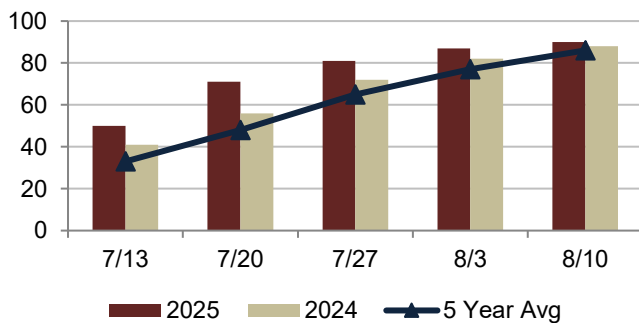

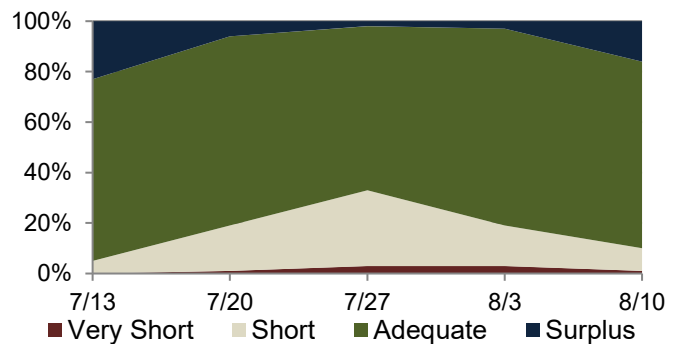

TOPSOIL MOISTURE PERCENT

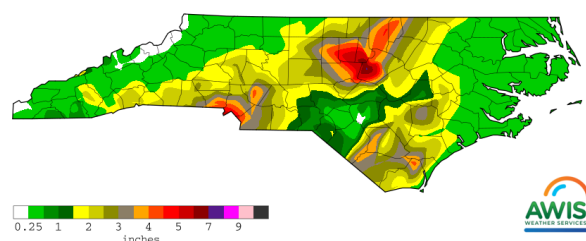


Map depicts current drought conditions as of August 5, 2025.
