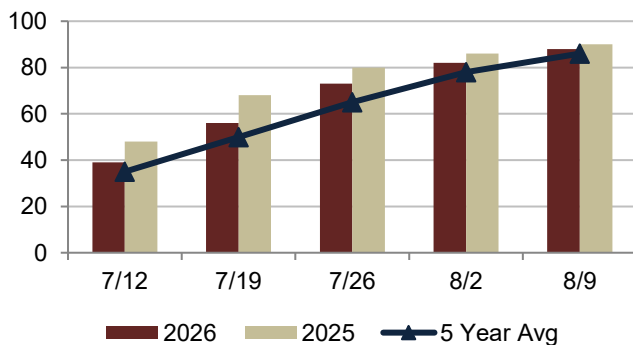

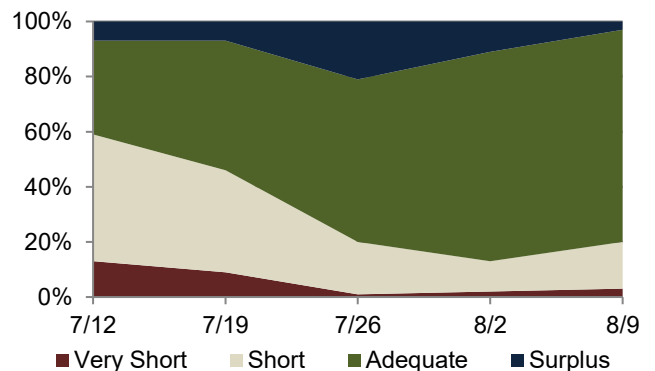

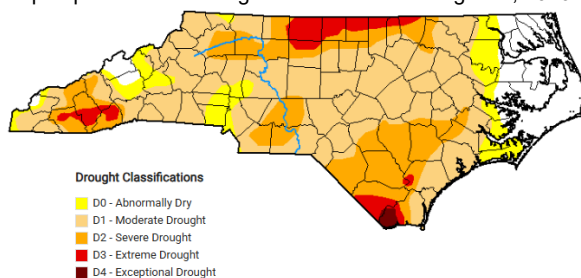
CORN DOUGHED



TOPSOIL MOISTURE PERCENT

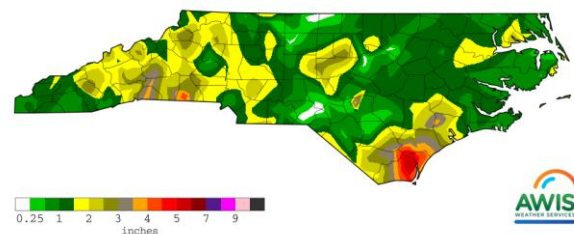


Map depicts current drought conditions as of August 4, 2026.
