



WHEAT STOCKS (Thousand Bushels)




CORN STOCKS (Thousand Bushels)



MONTHLY PRICE RECEIVED FOR SOYBEANS



MONTHLY PRICE RECEIVED FOR WINTER WHEAT





MONTHLY PRICE RECEIVED FOR CORN






FLUE-CURED TOBACCO YIELD (Pounds)




PEANUT YIELD (Pounds)






CORN FOR GRAIN YIELD (Bushels)





SOWS FARROWING

North Carolina producers intend to farrow 395,000 sows during the September – November 2024 quarter and 390,000 sows during the December 2024 - February 2025 quarter.

PIG CROP

The State's pig crop during the June-August 2024 period totaled 4.698 million head, down 1% from the same period last year. These pigs were produced by 405,000 sows.

PIGS PER LITTER

Pigs saved per litter averaged 11.60, which is up from the 11.30 pigs saved during the same quarter last year.

HOGS & PIGS

All hogs and pigs on North Carolina farms on September 1, 2024, totaled 8.2 million head, up 6% from last quarter and up 1% from last year. Market hogs, at 7.42 million head, is up 2% from last year.
