SEPTEMBER 2024 HOG REPORT

All hogs and pigs on North Carolina farms on September 1, 2024, totaled 8.2 million head, up 6% from last guarter and up 1% from last year. Market hogs, at 7.42 million head, is up 2% from last year. Breeding stock totaled 780,000 head, down 2% from last year. The State's pig crop during the June-August 2024 period totaled 4.698 million head, down 1% from the same period last year. These pigs were produced by 405,000 sows. Pigs saved per litter averaged 11.60, which is up from the 11.30 pigs saved during the same quarter last year. North Carolina producers intend to farrow 395,000 sows during the September-November 2024 guarter and 390,000 sows during the December 2024-February 2025 quarter. NC currently ranks 3rd nationally, behind lowa and Minnesota, in the total number of hogs and pigs produced.
