## NORTH DAKOTA CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION

**FARGO, N.D. January 6, 2025** - For the week ending January 5, 2025, topsoil moisture supplies rated 13% very short, 40% short, 44% adequate, and 3% surplus, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Subsoil moisture supplies rated 14% very short, 37% short, 46% adequate, and 3% surplus.

**Field Crops Report:** Winter wheat condition rated 4% very poor, 9% poor, 47% fair, 38% good, and 2% excellent.

Sunflowers harvested was 99%.

**Livestock Report:** Cattle and calf conditions rated 0% very poor, 2% poor, 25% fair, 69% good, and 4% excellent.

Sheep and lamb conditions rated 1% very poor, 2% poor, 29% fair, 62% good, and 6% excellent.

Hay and roughage supplies rated 0% very short, 13% short, 80% adequate, and 7% surplus.

Stock water supplies rated 12% very short, 26% short, 60% adequate, and 2% surplus.

The next report will be issued February 3, 2025.
