NORTH DAKOTA JUNE 1, 2024 GRAIN STOCKS

FARGO, N.D. June 28, 2024 - North Dakota **corn** stocks stored in all positions on June 1, 2024 totaled 163 million bushels, up 65% from a year ago, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. On-farm stocks of 120 million bushels are up 107% from 2023, and off-farm stocks of 42.8 million bushels are up 6% from last year.

All wheat stored in all positions totaled 108 million bushels, up 27% from a year ago. On-farm stocks of 63.0 million bushels are up 19% from 2023, and off-farm stocks of 44.8 million bushels are up 40% from last year.

Durum wheat stored in all positions totaled 6.71 million bushels, down 42% from a year ago. On-farm stocks of 5.00 million bushels are down 36% from 2023, and off-farm stocks at 1.71 million bushels are down 55% from last year.

Barley stored in all positions totaled 24.2 million bushels, up 19% from 2023. On-farm stocks are 10.5 million bushels, up 64% from last year, and off-farm stocks, at 13.7 million bushels, are down 1% from last year.

Soybeans stored in all positions totaled 34.9 million bushels, up 80% from last year. On-farm stocks, at 17.5 million bushels, are up 86% from a year ago, and off-farm stocks, at 17.4 million bushels, are up 75% from 2023.

Oats stored in all positions totaled 2.55 million bushels, down 26% from last year. On-farm stocks, at 2.00 million bushels, are down 26% from a year ago, and off-farm stocks of 545,000 bushels, are down 24% from 2023.
