NORTH DAKOTA MARCH 1, 2025 GRAIN STOCKS

FARGO, N.D. March 31, 2025 - North Dakota **corn** stocks stored in all positions on March 1, 2025 totaled 277 million bushels, up 5% from a year ago, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. On-farm stocks of 155 million bushels are down 9% from 2024, but off-farm stocks of 122 million bushels are up 31% from last year.

All wheat stored in all positions totaled 188 million bushels, up 7% from a year ago. On-farm stocks of 117 million bushels are up 17% from 2024, but off-farm stocks of 70.6 million bushels are down 7% from last year.

Durum wheat stored in all positions totaled 17.9 million bushels, up 28% from a year ago. Onfarm stocks of 12.5 million bushels are up 25% from 2024, and off-farm stocks of 5.4 million bushels are up 34% from last year.

Barley stored in all positions totaled 27.7 million bushels, down 20% from 2024. On-farm stocks are 12.0 million bushels, down 41% from last year, but off-farm stocks, at 15.7 million bushels, are up 11% from last year.

Oat on-farm stocks of 3.00 million bushels, are up 18% from a year ago.

Soybeans stored in all positions totaled 75.7 million bushels, up 29% from last year. On-farm stocks, at 39.5 million bushels, are up 22% from a year ago, and off-farm stocks, at 36.2 million bushels, are up 38% from 2024.

All sunflower stored in all positions totaled 276 million pounds, down 60% from 2024. **Oil sunflower** stocks are 197 million pounds, down 68% from last year. **Non-oil sunflower** stocks of 78.9 million pounds, are down 8% from a year ago.
