NORTH DAKOTA FEBRUARY 1 POTATO STOCKS

FARGO, N.D. February 17, 2022 - North Dakota growers, dealers, and processors held 11.3 million cwt of potatoes in storage on February 1, according to USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Current stocks represent 52% of the 2021 production. Total stocks are defined as all potatoes on hand, regardless of use, including those that will be lost through future shrinkage and dumping.

Comparing stocks by type, Russets accounted for 58% of the total, up from 56% in 2021. Whites were 24% of the total, down from 26% in 2021. Reds, at 13% of total stocks, were down from 15% in 2021. Yellows, at 5%, were up from 3% in 2021.
