NORTH DAKOTA FEBRUARY 1 POTATO STOCKS

FARGO, N.D. February 16, 2024 - North Dakota growers, dealers, and processors held 13.4 million cwt of potatoes in storage on February 1, according to USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Current stocks represent 51% of the 2023 production. Total stocks are defined as all potatoes on hand, regardless of use, including those that will be lost through future shrinkage and dumping.

Comparing stocks by type, Russets accounted for 52% of the total, down from 55% in 2023. Whites were 27% of the total, up from 24% in 2023. Reds, at 17% of total stocks, were up from 16% in 2023. Yellows, at 4%, were down from 5% in 2023.
