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NORTH DAKOTA 2024 FARM REAL ESTATE VALUE AND CASH RENT

FARGO, N.D. August 2, 2024 - North Dakota's **farm real estate value**, a measurement of the value of all land and buildings on farms, increased from 2023, according to USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Farm real estate value for 2024 averaged \$2,260 per acre, up \$120 per acre (up 6%) from last year.

Cropland value increased 6% from last year to \$2,600 per acre. **Pastureland**, at \$1,050 per acre, was \$63 higher than the previous year.

Cash rents paid to landlords in 2024 for cropland increased from last year. **Irrigated cropland rent** averaged \$192.00 per acre, \$3.00 above last year. **Dryland cropland rent** averaged \$81.50 per acre, \$5.50 higher than a year earlier. **Pasture** rented for cash averaged \$21.50 per acre, \$1.00 above the previous year.
