NORTH DAKOTA FARM NUMBERS LOWER

FARGO, N.D. February 16, 2024 - North Dakota's number of farms and ranches decreased during 2023, according to USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. The number of farms and ranches in the state, at 24,800, was down 300 farms from 2022. Numbers of farms and ranches in North Dakota with less than \$100,000 in agricultural sales decreased 400 farms from a year earlier while operations with more than \$100,000 in agricultural sales increased 100 farms.

Land in farms and ranches in North Dakota totaled 38.5 million acres, unchanged acres from 2022. The average size of operation, at 1,552 acres, was up 18 acres from a year earlier.
