NORTH DAKOTA JANUARY 1 CATTLE INVENTORY

FARGO, N.D. January 31, 2023 - **All cattle and calves** in North Dakota as of January 1, 2023, totaled 1.75 million head, down 6% from January 1, 2022, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service.

All cows and heifers that had calved totaled 890,000 head, down 6% from last year.

Beef cows totaled 876,000 head, down 6% from last year.

Milk cows totaled 14,000 head, down 7% from last year.

All heifers 500 pounds and over totaled 385,000 head, down 8% from last year.

Steers weighing 500 pounds and over totaled 305,000 head, down 2% from last year.

Bulls weighing 500 pounds and over totaled 55,000 head, down 8% from last year.

Calves under 500 pounds totaled 115,000 head, down 12% from January 1, 2022.

All cattle on feed fed for slaughter in North Dakota feedlots totaled 41,000 head, up 5% from the previous year.

The **2022 calf crop** totaled 850,000 head, down 8% from 2021.
