**Oklahoma** hatcheries set 7.47 million eggs in incubators during the week ending December 31, down 1 percent from the week prior and down 3 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of December 31, was 4.20 million, up 38 percent from the previous week but down 9 percent from the previous year. **Texas** hatcheries set 17.9 million eggs in incubators during the week ending December 31, down 1 percent from the week prior and down 3 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of December 31, was 14.6 million, down slightly from the previous week but up 1 percent from the previous year.
