**Oklahoma** hatcheries set 6.21 million eggs in incubators during the week ending August 17, up 6 percent from the week prior but down 12 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of August 17, was 5.42 million, up 30 percent from the previous week and up slightly from the previous year.

**Texas** hatcheries set 19.9 million eggs in incubators during the week ending August 17, up 2 percent from the week prior and up 7 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of August 17, was 15.6 million, up 1 percent from the previous week and up 8 percent from the previous year.
