Oklahoma hatcheries set 4.99 million eggs in incubators during the week ending October 19, up slightly from the week prior but down 21 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of October 19, was 4.26 million, down 6 percent from the previous week and down 4 percent from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 18.7 million eggs in incubators during the week ending October 19, down 3 percent from the week prior but up 12 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of October 19, was 15.2 million, up 2 percent from the previous week and up 5 percent from the previous year.
