

This report contains results from the August 2024 Cattle on Feed Survey collected during the first two weeks of August. Data provided by Oklahoma and Texas producers are the foundation of the estimates made for the Southern Plains region. We would like to thank all producers who responded to the survey. Results from the next monthly survey will be made available on September 20, 2024.

Cattle and calves on feed for slaughter market in **Texas** feedlots with capacity of 1,000 head or more totaled 2.74 million head on August 1, 2024, up 1 percent from a year ago. Producers placed 385 thousand head in commercial feedlots during July, up 3 percent from a year ago. Texas commercial feeders marketed 420 thousand head during July, up 17 percent from 2023.

On August 1, there were 2.45 million head of cattle and calves on feed in the Northern High Plains, 89 percent of the state's total. The number on feed across the area was up 1 percent from last year but down 2 percent from the July 1 total. July placements in the Northern High Plains totaled 341 thousand head, up 3 percent from the June total. Marketings were up 5 percent from last month at 373 thousand head.

Texas Cattle on Feed Inventory




Texas Cattle and Calves on Feed in 1.000+ Capacity Feedlots, by District


¹ Cattle and calves on feed are animals for slaughter market being fed a ration of grain or other concentrates and are expected to produce a carcass that will grade select or better.

² Included death losses, movement from feedlots to pasture and shipments to other feedlots for further feeding.



Cattle and calves on feed for slaughter market in **Oklahoma** feedlots with capacity of 1,000 head or more totaled 325 thousand head on August 1, 2024, up 27 percent from a year ago. Producers placed 45 thousand head in commercial feedlots during July, up 18 percent from a year ago. Oklahoma commercial feeders marketed 44 thousand head during July, up 38 percent from 2023. Other disappearance during July totaled 1 thousand head, unchanged from a year ago.
