


This report contains results from the October 2024 Milk Production Survey collected nationally during the first two weeks of October. Data provided by Oklahoma and Texas producers are the foundation of the estimates made for the Southern Plains region. We would like to thank all producers who responded to the survey. Results from the next quarterly survey will be made available on January 22, 2025.

Milk production in **Oklahoma** during the July-September quarter totaled 164 million pounds, down 14 percent from the April-June quarter, but up 10 percent from last year's quarter. The average number of milk cows in **Oklahoma** during the quarter totaled 40,000 head, up 3,000 head from the same quarter in 2023.

# Oklahoma Quarterly Milk Cow Inventory and Milk Production 2022 - 2024



Milk production in **Texas** during the July-September quarter totaled 4,259 million pounds, up 2 percent from the April-June quarter, and up 6 percent from last year's quarter. The average number of milk cows in **Texas** during the quarter totaled 654,000 head, up 19,000 head from the same quarter in 2023.

Milk production in the **United States** during the July-September quarter totaled 56.0 billion pounds, up slightly from the same quarter last year. The average number of milk cows in the **United States** during the quarter was 9.33 million head, down 3,000 head from the April-June quarter, and down 41,000 head from the same period last year.
