Note: The Southern Plains Region will begin to phase out regional and state-specific releases for each NASS report. This will be the last weekly Southern Plains Region Broiler report.

**Oklahoma** hatcheries set 5.81 million eggs in incubators during the week ending April 12, up 1 percent from the week prior and up 3 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of April 12, was 3.94 million, up 20 percent from the previous week but down 22 percent from the previous year.

**Texas** hatcheries set 19.4 million eggs in incubators during the week ending April 12, down slightly from the week prior but up slightly from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of April 12, was 14.7 million, down 1 percent from the previous week and down 1 percent from the previous year.
