# Crop Progress & Condition

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Week ending June 21, 2020

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According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Pennsylvania, there were 6.5 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday; June 21<sup>st</sup>, 2020. Topsoil moisture supplies were 6 percent very short, 25 percent short, 66 percent adequate, and 3 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 5 percent very short, 14 percent short and 81 percent adequate.
